13 April 1941: "Mr [Frank] Grimmer had Easter Comm for over 70 this morning in Woodstock & back to the Corner at 8:30, then down to Kirkland at 9:45 & back to the Falls at 15 past 11. ... Said he got stuck just 3 times."

2 June 1991: "Worst road ever saw. Potholes foot and half deep."
